Botany/zoology/Life Sciences/Biosciences/Genetics/Micro biology/Bio-technology/molecular biology/ plant physiology provided they have studied Botany and zoology at Graduation level.
TGT (English)	1. English as a subject in all three years of Graduation and B.Ed with English as a teaching subject. 2. Pass in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) (Paper – II), conducted by CBSE in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCERT for the purpose.
TGT (Hindi/Sanskrit)	1. Hindi and / or Sanskrit as a elective subject in all the three years of graduation along with B.Ed. with Hindi or Sanskrit as a teaching subject. 2. Pass in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) (Paper – II), conducted by CBSE in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCERT for the purpose.
TGT (Maths/Physics)	1. Mathematics and/or Physics in all three years of graduation and B.Ed with Science or Maths as a teaching subject. 2. Pass in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) (Paper – II), conducted by CBSE in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCERT for the purpose.
TGT (Bio./Chemistry)	1. Chemistry, Botany and Zoology in all three years of Graduation and B.Ed with Biology and/or Chemistry as a teaching subject.
PRT	i) Senior Secondary School Certificate with 50% marks or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University / Institution's norms) OR Intermediate or its equivalent with 50% marks or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University / Institution's norms) OR Diploma in Prachin Kala Kendra. ii) English as a subject in Class XII is mandatory. iii) Proficiency in teaching in English medium. iv) The candidate should possess two years Diploma in Education (D.Ed.) or Bachelor in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed.). v) Pass in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) (Paper – I) conducted by CBSE in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose. vi) Working knowledge of computer desirable
