Sub: Reimbursement of cost of medicine purchased at outside pharmacy - Reg.


In view of the present COVID-19 pandemic, all efforts are being taken by NFC to contain its impact by instituting many preventive measures. As a part of the continuing efforts in this direction, Competent Authority in NFC has accorded approval for allowing the CHSS beneficiaries to purchase the regular medicines for all chronic ailments prescribed by Super Specialty Hospitals / Zonal Hospitals / AMAs and medicines not issued by them.

2. The prescribed medicines are allowed to purchase at their nearest pharmacy, as a special case from 01.05.2021 to 30.06.2021 and submit the bills in original for reimbursement in the prescribed format.

3. All the Prime beneficiaries of CHSS (Serving / Retired) are advised to submit the claim along with original bill, copy of prescription, copy of CHSS card & Health Pass Book, copy of Bank Pass Book within one month from the date of purchase of Medicines at any of the drop boxes placed at Aadhar Building or at Sanjivini.

4. All beneficiaries of CHSS are requested to note the above.


