CIRCULAR

Subject: COVID-19 vaccination drive at Colony Health Centre (CHC), NFC for
CHSS beneficiaries – Reg.

As per the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, all citizens above the age of 18 years have to be vaccinated after getting self registered in Co-WIN or Arogyasetu App.

2. In this regard, a special COVID vaccination drive (Covishield vaccine manufactured by M/s.Serum Institute of India) is being conducted to the following CHSS beneficiaries on all working days from 25.06.2021 onwards at CHC, Sanjivini:

Sl.No	Description	Venue
01	CHSS beneficiaries of age group between 18 years to 44 years (for 1 st dose only)	COVID-19 Block, Colony Health Centre (CHC), Sanjivini, DAE Colony.
02	CHSS beneficiaries of age 45 years and above (for 1 st or 2 nd dose of vaccination)	1 st Floor, Colony Health Centre (CHC), Sanjivini, DAE Colony.

3. For this purpose, CHSS beneficiaries of NFC who are between the age group of 18 years to 44 years (as mentioned in Sl.No.1) and who are desirous of taking vaccination may register themselves through a link ("Book Vaccination Slot") provided at NFC website (www.nfc.gov.in) or by directly accessing www.sanjivini.chsshyd.org. Use "Register for Vaccination" option/button for booking a slot. On successful registration, an SMS will be received by the Beneficiary. Please refer FAQ (Frequently asked Questions) link for more details.

4. CHSS Beneficiaries of age 45 years and above who have already taken 1st dose of Covishield vaccination and are due for 2nd dose can directly walk in for vaccination to the 1st Floor, Colony Health Centre (CHC), Sanjivini, DAE Colony for 2nd dose of vaccination (Covishield vaccine only) on all working days between 09.30 Hrs to 12.00 Hrs and 13.00 Hrs to 15.30 Hrs. Similarly, CHSS Beneficiaries of age 45 years and above who have missed the first dose of vaccination can also walk in directly for vaccination to CHC, Sanjivini.


5. Beneficiaries shall carry CHSS Health Pass Book along with CHSS card and Aadhar Card or any other valid document entered at the time of registration, while visiting Colony Health Centre (CHC) for availing the said facility. Beneficiaries shall show the SMS received in their mobile phone at Sanjivini Gate for entry purpose on the specified date and time of vaccination.

6. Serving employees of NFC who are between the age group of 18 years to 44 years may kindly note that the vaccination shall continue at Occupational Health Centre as per the schedule mentioned as per Circular No. NFC/CHSS/2021/938 dated 21.06.2021.

7. All CHSS Beneficiaries are requested to kindly note that Colony Health Centre (CHC), Sanjivini will be functional during General Shift only till the completion of the said vaccination drive.

8. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority in NFC.
