Essential

(i)Master's Degree from a recognized University with atleast 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/institution's norms) in the following subject.

OR

Two years Integrated Post Graduate Course of Regional College of Education of NCERT in the following subject with atleast 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/institution's norms).

OR

Post Graduate degree in the following subjects with atleast 50% marks in aggregate or its equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/institution's norms) from a recognized university and B.A.Ed./B.Sc.Ed. from a recognized institute.

Essential

- (i) Three years Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University with atleast 50% marks or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/Institution's norms) in the concerned subjects/combination of subjects and as well as in aggregate.

OR

Four years integrated degree course of Regional College of Education of NCERT with atleast 50% marks or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/Institution's norms) in the concerned subjects/combination of subjects as well as in aggregate.

MODE OF SELECTION

- i Written test—The screening shall be made through objective type of test (MCQs) for 50 marks in the respective subject for 1 hour. Candidates scoring 50% or above (Gen) and 45% or above (SC/ST/OBC/PH) will be considered for Skill test.
- ii Skill test—For the candidates short-listed on the basis of written test. The Selected candidates will be empanelled and will be operated as per the arrival of the vacancies in AEC Schools/Jr.Colleges at Hyderabad.
