INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. Your Roll No. as given in Stage-I Preliminary test will be same for Stage-2 (Interview) and has to be quoted wherever required and may be preserved for future correspondence.
2. You are advised to locate the Test centre one day in advance.
3. **You are required to reach and report at the venue by 0800 hrs on 05.02.2021.**
4. **You are required to bring original of any one of the valid Photo Identity Proof viz., Passport, Driving Licence, Aadhar Card, Voter Identity Card or PAN Card for verification at Test centre.**
5. **Certificates to be submitted:** Candidates who are called for Stage-2 Interview are required to produce printout of online application along with originals and self attested copies of certificates mentioned below:
 - a. Educational qualifications and technical qualifications (supported by appropriate mark sheets) starting from (SSC) X standard onwards.
 - b. Date of birth/Proof of age.
 - c. SC certificate issued by an Authority duly authorized to issue such Certificate in the prescribed format and the caste/community should have been included in the Presidential orders in relation to the concerned State.
 - d. Candidates claiming reservation under EWS are required to produce Income and Asset certificate in the prescribed format enclosed to this advertisement duly issued by the Competent Authority.
 - e. "No Objection Certificate" in case the candidate is working under Central/State Government, Public Sector Undertakings/Autonomous Bodies.
 - f. Proof to the effect that they have been affected by 1984 riots (if claiming age relaxation).
 - g. Certificate regarding domiciled in Kashmir Division from 01.01.1980 to 31.12.1989 (if claiming age relaxation for Kashmir division).
6. **Candidates who fail to submit the above documents will not be allowed to appear for Stage-2 Interview.**
7. You are not permitted to carry books, reading material, Calculator, Mobile Phone, Bluetooth Devices, all kinds of watches, Smart Trackers, Fitness band or any other electronic devices for attending Interview.

8. Outstation SC/ST candidates are eligible for payment of TA equivalent to second class Train Fare or bus fare by the shortest route from their place of residence. The candidates are required to produce copy of (i) certificate of Non-employment from MP/MLA/Gazetted Officer of the place where the candidate normally resides, (ii) original travel ticket/proof of travel and (iii) caste certificate at the time of Stage-1 Test for reimbursement of TA. The TA amount as admissible will be remitted into the Bank account of the candidate separately. Candidates are advised to download the TA claim form from NFC website www.nfc.gov.in or www.nfcrecruitment.aptonline.in.
9. No request for change of Venue/Date/Time will be entertained.
10. The result of the Select Panel will be displayed separately on website www.nfcrecruitment.aptonline.in and www.nfc.gov.in.
11. The candidates are required to visit the NFC website for results, schedules and other notices related to recruitment from time to time as no postal communication will be sent in this regard.
12. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
13. Wearing of mask/face covers is mandatory for all candidates. Candidates without mask/face covers will not be allowed entry into the venue.
